

## ACT Prep Commitment Form

The Cherokee Nation Foundation and The Princeton Review have partnered together to offer a **free**, **6-week** ACT prep class to high school **juniors and seniors** who are citizens of Cherokee Nation. (Lower grades are welcome if space is available AND if they have taken Algebra 1 and are enrolled in Geometry.)

This class is free of charge to you but normally costs over \$600. You will be provided with materials that you will need to bring to each class, as well as receive homework assignments you will need to complete between classes. You are required to register for the upcoming National ACT and agree to be on time and stay for the duration of each class meeting.

## If a student is not a citizen of a federally recognized tribe, the cost of the class is \$100.
