The Cherokee Nation Foundation and The Princeton Review have partnered together to offer a **free, 6-week** ACT prep class to high school **juniors and seniors** who are citizens of Cherokee Nation. *(Lower grades are welcome if space is available AND if they have taken Algebra 1 and are enrolled in Geometry.)*

This class is free of charge to you but normally costs over \$600. You will be provided with materials that you will need to bring to each class, as well as receive homework assignments you will need to complete between classes. **You are required to register for the upcoming National ACT and agree to be on time and stay for the duration of each class meeting.**

If a student is not a citizen of a federally recognized tribe, the cost of the class is \$100.
